


## Saving Empty Brio Documents


When saving a Brio Document without the results, the reporting sections will still retain the old data when the document is viewed. This data will remain unchanged until the query is refreshed or processed.

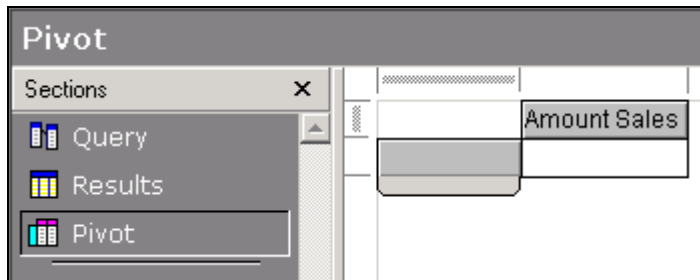
If you would like to store the document without any data and without any data showing, create a bogus limit so that zero results are returned, process the document, then remove the limit and save the document.
